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In the fields of cosmology and ontology, physicists and philosophers sit in their ivory towers theorizing and philosophizing about the presence of unseen forces that *must (a priori)* exist in order to make sense of things like the fundamental nature of our universe. One of these invisible forces we Earthlings have all heard about are the gravitational behemoths known as Black Holes. Oenologists and Viticulturists, while not concerned with such grandiose existential matters, do have their own “Black Hole” to contend with, namely the concept of *Terroir*. *Terroir* has no precise definition, nor is its’ existence scientifically verifiable. In fact science argues for the myth of *Terroir*, rather than the truth of it. How can science be blamed for this opinion in the seeming absence of any observable phenomena?

When a sommelier speaks about a wine having a “sense of place” or “authenticity of expression” he or she is speaking of the wines’ *Terroir*, wines that express not only a particular place & time, but a unique culture, tradition, and way of life. How can a glass of fermented grape juice do so much, given the fact that scientists cannot even write an equation describing *Terroir*’s merely theoretical existence? Not an easy question to answer if you are worried about the math. Here’s the rub, for centuries wine lovers and experts alike have discussed & contemplated the nuances of vintage variation, the subtle aromatic differences of Barolo versus Barbaresco, the minerality found in the steep Riesling vineyards of the Mosel, the *sauvage* quality of Côte Rôtie’s Syrah based wines...etc. What has all of this talk and contemplation been about if *Terroir* did not, and does not, exist? Why don’t all red wines, and white wines, made from the same variety, smell and taste the same? Why does a Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon harvested in 1999 taste different than one harvested in 1998? These are some of the questions that *Terroir* answers. It is my contention that just like a Black Hole *must* exist at the center of the Milky Way in order to keep our galaxy from spinning apart, so *must* *Terroir* be woven into the fabric of all great wines in order to keep them from falling into homogeneous ubiquity.

The two general expressions (or personas) of wine are imprecisely referred to as *Old-World* and *New-World*. Now with all due respect to espousers of *Old-World* tradition, the world of wine (like the world itself) is in constant motion and ever changing. These changes have been ongoing for thousands of years, and are certain to continue for as long as wine is enjoyed. The transplantation of varieties from the *Old-World* (Europe & The Mediterranean Basin) to the *New-World* (The Americas, Australia, South Africa, New Zealand) is perhaps the most discernible example of change in the wine world.

Most wine professionals look to the *Old-World* as the established home, and hence expression, of traditional wine-grape varieties. However, many of these varieties have been brought to the *New-World* with great success. The point here is that while these varieties, and their resulting wines, will be different than their *Old-World* cousins, they still possess the potential for showing themselves to have unique voices which express quality, balance, subtlety and the pièce de résistance—terroir. Listed below are wonderful examples of *New-World* wines made from varieties which are more commonly heard speaking with *Old-World* voices. We have also listed classic selections of the each variety from the *Old-World*, if you would rather start there. The joy we receive from the simple pleasure of drinking wine will only be heightened if we open ourselves up to all of the varied expressions with which wine speaks—*Old* and *New*.
